

Alabama State History Field Trip Scholarships

Alabama State History Field Trip Scholarships are available to fourth-grade students across Alabama who lack the financial resources to participate in class field trips to Montgomery that include tours of the Alabama State Capitol and/or the Alabama Department of Archives & History.

This scholarship is made possible by Secretary of State John H. Merrill and Tom Ward, co-authors of *Alabama: The Bicentennial*, published in 2019. Seventy-five percent of proceeds from book sales are dedicated to support fourth-graders' visits to Montgomery to learn about the rich history of our state. Scholarships are coordinated by the Friends of the Alabama Archives, a non-profit auxiliary of the Alabama Department of Archives & History. Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis as long as funds are available.

Who May Apply?

Any student who:

- 1. Attends fourth grade in a public or private school in Alabama
- 2. Lacks financial resources to pay the standard rate established by their school for participation in a class field trip to Montgomery
- 3. Will be touring the Alabama State Capitol and/or Alabama Department of Archives & History during the field trip

How to Apply

- 1. The classroom teacher should complete Form A, Part 1, providing information on the schedule and cost of the field trip.
- 2. A parent or guardian should complete Form A, Part 2, and return it to the school to verify the need for funding.
- 3. The field trip coordinator (classroom teacher, principal, or central office staff) should collect Form A upon completion from participating classrooms for the completion of Form B.
- 4. The field trip coordinator should prepare one Form B for all participating classrooms, indicating:
 - a. The date and destination(s) of the field trip to Montgomery, with certification that reservations for tours at the Alabama State Capitol and/or the Alabama Department of Archives & History have been confirmed
 - b. The cost per student to participate in the field trip
 - c. The number of students in the school requiring financial assistance to participate
 - d. A statement that other, local funds are not available to support the students' participation
- 5. The field trip coordinator should send Form B to the Alabama Department of Archives & History at the address on the form <u>at least two weeks before the field trip.</u> Awards will not be made retroactively to cover the costs of field trips already completed.

Transmittal of Funds

Upon the review and approval of Form B, the Friends of the Alabama Archives will send one check, payable to the school, to the address provided on Form B, and send an email of notice to the email address provided. The field trip coordinator should report the award to participating classroom teachers. **Note: Upon receiving notice from the Friends of the Alabama Archives, the school is responsible for informing the parent or guardian of the student(s).**
